Project Summary

When the Village of Issaquah YWCA needed a cost-effective, sustainable bridge with modern aesthetics, they chose GatorBridge™. The YWCA had been working for years to create a Family Village, a community of residential, commercial, retail and recreational areas. Located 20 miles outside of Seattle, this area provides 146 affordable apartments for those with disabilities, seniors and for families in need. GatorBridge custom designed the 293-foot bridge to span from the residential and commercial complex, arching high above the downtown streets to reach recreational facilities on the other side. The design includes multiple points of entry, one of which incorporates a custom security gate. This project received the 2011 Green Globe Award for its sustainability and 'Green' design. Since the project completion, the Village of Issaquah has ordered another GatorBridge which will be delivered Fall of 2011.
